Serious about hunting trophy whitetail deer? The Alabama River Lodge, L.L.C., in the heart of the Black Belt -- famed for its Boone-and-Crockett class bucks -- is a must. The **Alabama River Lodge, L.L.C.** offers hunting on 12,000 acres of prime, privately owned plantation land along the Alabama River, just south of Selma and 45 minutes from the Montgomery airport. The comfortable new lodge is steps away from deer, turkey, and wingshooting in a fair chase environment.

The Hain-Beers family and friends have been bagging record-class deer on the land for generations. Long under a rigorous deer-management program, now the Alabama River Lodge, L.L.C. offers you the same excellent hunting. Seasoned guides, roomy quarters and the true Southern hospitality of home cooking and good stories are hallmarks of the Alabama River Lodge, L.L.C..

At the **Alabama River Lodge, L.L.C.**, approximately 6,000 acres are reserved for trophy buck harvesting only — any size buck may be taken on the 6,000 remaining acres. Does can be harvested on all of the land. January is our rutting season, but many outstanding bucks have been harvested during November and December.

Hunting will be done from gun houses located on green field plots, or from safe ladder stands located on trails, scrape lines, or pasture land.

Hunting Times

Morning Hunt: 5:15 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.
Afternoon Hunt 2:00 p.m. to dark

- Beautiful Lodge — 5,000 square foot lodge with comfortable rooms, satellite systems, and good old Southern cooking.
- Guides will be present to give you plenty of individual attention: organizing your hunts, placing you on your stand, helping sight in rifles, etc.

- Hunter pickup is available at the Montgomery airport for \$300 round trip for groups of six or fewer.

- Non-hunter rate is \$250 per day

- Deer Cleaning is available at our local processor — skinned and quartered for your cooler or processed (steaks, hamburger, etc) and packaged.

What to Bring ...

- Hunter orange is required to and from the stand. A hat is the minimum.
- An Alabama Hunting License. Licenses are available online (outdooralabama.com) or via toll-free number (1-888-848-6887) for your convenience.
- Your rifle/bow, arrows/ammo, flashlight, rain gear, waterproof boots, portable treestand (especially for bow hunters), warm clothing, and ice chests (for taking home venison).
- Prices, seasons and bag-limits are subject to change.

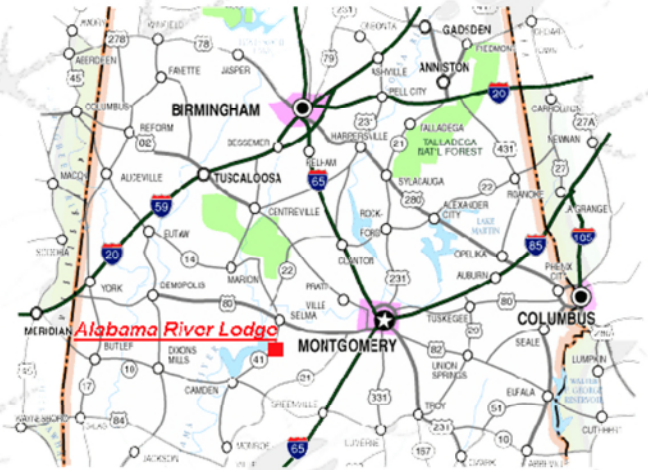

Directions

Take Alabama Highway 41 South from U.S. 80 to first caution light, in the community of Sardis. Turn right on County Road 30, heading west. (Sardis is 7 miles south of U.S. Highway 80 on Highway 41 South). Remain on 30, bearing to the right. The road number changes to 138. Stay on 138 until you see the lodge on your left.



Bookings:

Bookings are made on a first come, first served basis. A deposit of 50% is required for each hunter to confirm the reservation. This deposit must be received within two weeks after the reservation is made. The balance is due upon arrival. Cash and money orders are accepted. Personal checks are accepted for deposits only. No refunds.

BOW SEASON: Bow hunters may harvest a buck or doe per day, up to the state-wide 3-buck maximum and antler restrictions.

3	Buck OR doe per day	\$900	\$2,000
5	Buck OR doe per day	\$1,500	\$3,300

SEASON: Mid-March to April 30.
